

Covid-19 Update

- An ever-changing picture for schools, requiring significant amounts of time each day
- New guidance was published by the Scottish Government last week: Guidance on reducing the risks from Covid-19 in schools (
- This is a 69-page document that detailed specific changes for schools and parent
- The most significant change was the requirement for staff and parents to wear masks, while maintaining 2m physical distancing
- An update was sent to parents last week and again today,
 with details of what staff are also doing in school

Interim Reports


- These will be sent home on Friday 13th November, along with assessment folders.
- They will look very similar to the reports that parents will receive in June 2021, as we decided to implement the new coding system being introduced by SLC now.
- I am aware there have been a few queries as to why we have not made phone calls. We decided on reports for a number of reasons:
 - The written report will provide more details than a 7-minute phone call
 - The written report will provide a record of progress that can be seen and kept (rather than a phone call where details may be forgotten)
 - There is a better opportunity for parents to reflect on the report before completing the feedback sheet with any questions or comments
 - We only have 2 phone lines in the school! 372 phone calls @ 7 minutes each is equal to 2,604 minutes (43.4 hours, or almost 9 school days).

Since returning in August, all our classes have been helping to write a new Mossy Book!


This is a collection of stories all about Mossy's Hopes and Dreams, which hopefully reflects some of our pupils wishes too!
